

Minutes – Downtown Merchants of Rosenberg (DMOR)
June 10, 2010

The meeting was called to order at 5:30. The minutes were approved with one correction.

Mike Mercado suggested that DMOR consider an annual event similar to the Anniversary celebration. It was suggested that the "Nickel Day" might be an event that could grow to become such an annual event for the Downtown District.

New Business: Guests, Diana and Judy, introduced the Fort Bend Art League that is now housed at 2205 Avenue I. This is a wonderful addition to the community and it appears this will be a long time home for the league.

The next events are the Concerts in the Park, July 4th celebration, the Houston Glass Show and the October Car Show.

Linda Rulau made a motion that the July meeting be canceled and the next meeting to be held in August. Janice Vyoral seconded. The motion passed unanimously.
