DMOR would like to suggest that more than one A-frame sign be allowed per business in order to allow each store to advertise at each entrance. This will be discussed with the City of Rosenberg subcommittee and Noel, Marcia and Christy will attend the City Council meeting regarding this addition to the existing ordinance.

The Vogelsang Building's 100<sup>th</sup> Year Anniversary to be held June 5<sup>th</sup> was discussed. The picture of the Grand Opening in 1910 will be recreated at 9:00AM. Red Queens Attic will act as the point shop to run an old time bake sale to benefit DMOR. CAST will perform two short "Buster Brown" comics and there will be all day activities. The Vogelsangs have done a tremendous amount of advertising that should help raise awareness of the historic downtown area.
